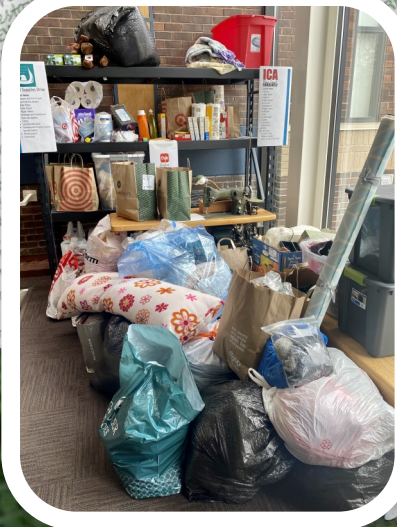


Renewing Our Commitment to Serve
