Our Etiquette Guidelines

Sending A Message

When you send an e-mail to <u>dismantlingracism@googlegroups.com</u> you are sending an
e-mail to everyone in the West Metro Dismantling Racism Network. Only send a
message to the entire Network when it contains information that is relevant to the work
of dismantling racism and could benefit everyone on the distribution list.

- State concisely and clearly the topic of your comments in the subject line. This allows
 members to respond more appropriately to your posting and makes it easier for
 members to search the archives by subject.
- Warn other list subscribers of lengthy messages either in the subject line or at the beginning of the message body with a line that says "Long Message."
- Include a signature tag on all messages that contains your name, affiliation, location, and e-mail address.

Replying to a Message

- Do not use "Reply All" unless the content of your response is likely to be relevant to all members of the Network.
- Include only the relevant portions of the original message in your reply. Delete any header information and put your response before the original posting.
- Send messages such as "thanks for the information" or "me, too" to the sender of the original e-mail using the "Reply" feature.
- Don't start a new train of thought by replying to an old message. Start a new message when you are bringing up a new topic.
